Sightseeing Around Numazu

Numazu, located on the scenic Izu Peninsula, faces Suruga Bay and is close to Mount Fuji. The surrounding area offers a variety of attractions that can be enjoyed as day trips during your visit. Tokyo is also accessible in about one hour from Numazu via Mishima Station by the Tokaido Shinkansen, making it possible to visit Tokyo on a day trip.

Mishima 三島 –

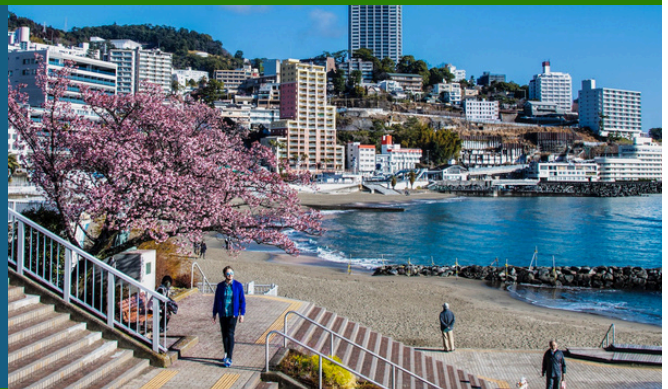
